In addition, on October 8, 2022 Roche announced that Gantenerumab had been granted Breakthrough Therapy Designation by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration. Roche's clinical trial results are to read out in the immediate future, and they will be presenting the findings on their lead investigational anti-amyloid monoclonal anti body Gantenerumab on November 30, 2022.

As the leading investigator for both the Lecanemab compound and Ganteneramb, enrolling more patients in these trials with both compounds than any other research facility in the world, Dr. David Watson will be attending this prestigious conference along with other worldwide leaders to discuss new results in the treatment of Alzheimer's disease and prevention. Both of these compounds have advanced into prevention trials, and it has been shown ARTC can detect the onset of AD years ahead of time now.

Dr. Watson will be able to offer additional subjects that participate in the open label trial with this compound next month testing the sub cutaneous formulation free of charge.
